

What is a Benchmark?



A program (or suite of programs)
used to assess the
performance characteristics
of one or more computer systems

Why Do We Need Benchmarks?



To measure and study the behavior of a class of applications in a practical and repeatable way

Benchmark Uses




Benchmarks are used for a variety of purposes:

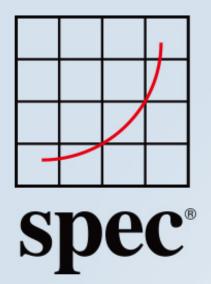
- Marketing

Different uses call for different types of benchmarks:


